The tablature is organized into four systems of six measures each. Measure numbers 5, 9, and 13 are indicated at the start of their respective systems. Chord names (A, D, E) and techniques (Sl, Po, H) are placed above the staff lines. The strings are labeled D, B, G, and g from top to bottom.

Measures 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7 are pretty much the same. You can choose the quick slide to measure 4, like in measure 1, the alternate string pull off like in measure 3, or the plain notes like in measure 6, Mix it up.
