The guitar tab for "Pretty Polly" is written for a guitar with a capo at the second fret. It consists of four systems of five measures each. The strings are labeled D, B, G, D, g from top to bottom. The notation includes fret numbers (0, 2, 3), slide techniques (S), hammer-ons (H), and circled numbers (9). Some notes are enclosed in parentheses, indicating they can be omitted for syncopation. The piece ends with a double bar line at the end of the fourth system.

The 2--3 slides can also be played open---slide into 3. "Sometimes the landing is more important than the take-off."

The notes in parentheses are either quiet, or not played. This leads to a syncopation (i-skip) in measure 5.
