The guitar tab is written for a guitar with a capo at the second fret. The key signature is D major. The tab is organized into five systems, each representing a line of music. Chord names are placed above the staff, and fret numbers are placed on the strings. Fingerings are indicated by numbers 1-4. A double bar line is used to separate systems. A repeat sign with first and second endings is used at the end of the piece.

System 4: H (0 3), Po (2 0), D (2 0), A (2 0 3 2 0), H (0 3 2 0), Po (0 2 5 5)

System 5: G (0 2 5), H (0 3), 1. A (2 0), D (2 0), 2. A (2 0), D (2 0)
