The guitar tab for "Rocky Mountain Goat" is written for a D major key signature with a capo on the 2nd fret. The piece is divided into four systems of notation, each starting with a measure number and a key signature. The notation includes fret numbers, accidentals, and techniques such as palm mutes (Po) and hammer-ons (H). The strings are labeled from top to bottom as D, C, G, C, G, and 5c2.
