Measure 3 has a G chord (0-2-0-0-0-0) and a hammer-on (H) on the 2nd fret of the 4th string. Measure 4 has a D chord (0-0-0-2-0-0) and a pull-off on the 2nd fret of the 4th string. Measure 5 has a G chord (0-2-0-0-0-0) and a pull-off on the 1st fret of the 4th string. Measure 6 has a D chord (0-0-0-2-0-0) and a pull-off on the 2nd fret of the 4th string. Measure 7 has a G chord (0-2-0-0-0-0) and a hammer-on on the 2nd fret of the 4th string. Measure 8 has a D chord (0-0-0-2-0-0) and a pull-off on the 2nd fret of the 4th string. Measure 9 has a G chord (0-2-0-0-0-0) and a pull-off on the 1st fret of the 4th string. Measure 10 has a D chord (0-0-0-2-0-0) and a pull-off on the 2nd fret of the 4th string. Measure 11 has a G chord (0-2-0-0-0-0) and a pull-off on the 1st fret of the 4th string. Measure 12 has a D chord (0-0-0-2-0-0) and a pull-off on the 2nd fret of the 4th string. The piece ends with a double bar line.
