The guitar tab is organized into four systems of six measures each. Measure numbers 1, 5, 9, and 13 are indicated at the start of each system. Chords A, E, and D are marked above the staff. Techniques such as Slides (Sl), Pull-offs (Po), and Hammer-ons (H) are indicated with arrows and text. Fingering numbers (0-4) are shown for various notes. The piece ends with a double bar line at the end of the fourth system.

Measures 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7 are pretty much the same. You can choose the quick slide to measure 4, like in measure 1, the alternate string pull off like in measure 3, or the plain notes like in measure 6, Mix it up.
