Detailed description: This guitar tab is for the song 'Flowers Of Edinburgh' in G major. It is divided into three sections: A, B, and C. Section A (measures 1-8) starts with a G chord and a barre on the first fret. It features a mix of open strings and fretted notes, with chords Em, G, C, and D. Section B (measures 9-16) begins with a G chord and a barre on the second fret.
